LOCAL RULES

The Lil Wick is a unique core golf course that is in close proximity of adjacent amenities. Please take care and caution in your play and choose tees appropriate to your playing level.

1. Check in at the Watering Hole prior to teeing off. If unattended, mark your name and tee time on the Starter's Board and proceed to the first tee.
2. Always watch out for pedestrians crossing the course to the seating areas or the Watering Hole.
3. Balls hit in the water hazard or desert landscape, will be played as a lateral hazard with a one stroke penalty.
4. Balls striking a manmade object which cause the ball to come to rest in the water hazard or desert landscape will be placed within two club lengths of such manmade object, no closer to the green.
5. Balls which come to rest with a manmade object obstructing the player's shot can be moved laterally until the player has an unobstructed shot, no closer to the green.
6. Players choosing to stop play mid round to enjoy the seating areas or the Watering Hole can restart their round on the same tee or alternate tee, by starting after the group on the preceding hole's green has played and teed off on the next hole, provided the preceding hole is open.
7. The pace of play is casual, but holding up pace of play is discouraged. If you are playing at a leisurely pace, let the group behind play through and continue to enjoy your game.
